<input type="checkbox"/> <b>First Aid Kit</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Buff</b> (multiple uses!)
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Tech</b> (e.g. phone, power bank)	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Beanie &amp; Gloves</b> (in cold weather)
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Dry Bag</b> (for valuables & tech)	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Toothbrush &amp; Toothpaste</b> (a lightweight luxury!)
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Water bottles</b> (x2 litre capacity)	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Gaffa Tape</b> (50-100 cm)
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Purification tablets</b> (or boil instead)	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Cord</b> (2 m)
